Once the meal is completed guests will head outside for our infamous Farmyard Sheep Race.

Afterwards adjourn to the barn where you will be entertained by a spectacle of music and dance programmes featuring the best of Irish culture. As a guest, you can learn a traditional Irish song and experience age-old storytelling; taste sumptuous food and when the party really gets going, you can sit back and listen to Irish traditional music or, in true Irish spirit, step up and join the craic (fun)!
