WINTERAGE CATTLE DRIVE Follow local landowners (Carrucan family) & their cattle up to their winter pastures. This is a 12km or 4km roundtrip. WHEN: 11am-3.30pm ADM: Locally made walking sticks available in lieu of donation to Burrenbeo Trust (€5-10pp). WHERE: FANORE O'Donohue's Pub WARNING: NO DOGS ALLOWED. Longer walk (12km roundtrip): 11am: meet at O'Donohue's pub for registration and refreshments to leave at midday, walking up the hill to Ballyally to meet the cattle for a blessing from the priest. Then walk up onto the Green road with cattle. This is a good walk, with a good climb and only for the reasonably fit. There will be a chance to hear from the farmer before descending the hill. Shorter walk (4km roundtrip): 11am: meet at O'Donohue's pub for registration and refreshments to leave at 12.10pm. Go in convoy by car to the top of the mountain – road will be closed thereafter - and wait for the cattle to come up. Then walk up along the Green road which is relatively flat and return same way. Bring good walking shoes, outdoor clothes. Afterwards 3.30pm-5pm: Option to have a local Burren stew and tea - available for the walkers @ €10pp (not included in above donation) in O'Donohue's pub. Followed by singing (4.30pm) and music (5pm).
